⁴ Praise him with tambourine and dance;

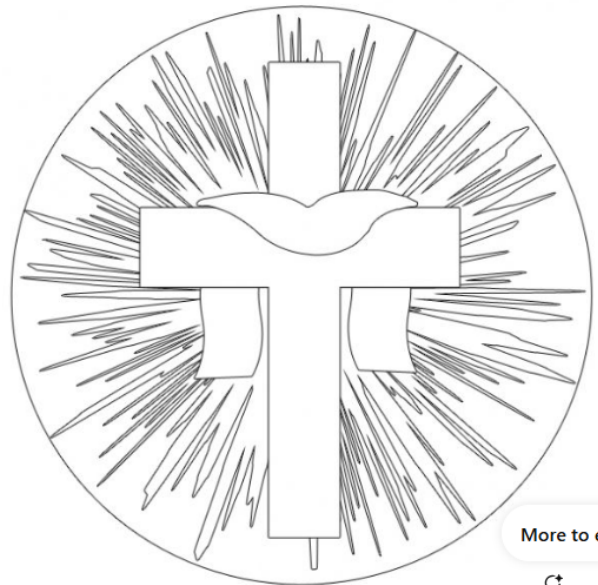
