- 1 I will extol you O Lord for you have lifted me up: you have not let my enemies triumph over me.
- 2 O Lord my God I cried to you for help: and you have restored my health.
- 3 Lord you have brought me back from the dead: you have saved my life from among those going down to the Abyss.
- 4 Let all your servants sing praises to you O Lord: and give thanks to your holy name.
- 5 For your anger is but for a moment, and in your kindness is life: tears may linger at nightfall, but joy comes with the dawn.
- 6 In my prosperity I said, 'I shall never be shaken: your favour O Lord has made me as firm as any strong mountain.'
- 7 You turned your face away from me: and I was greatly dismayed.

to the Lord I made my appeal.
