First Reading: Genesis 32:22–31

Psalm 17:1–7, 15 (ANZPB-HKMoA) –
at 10am the psalm is sung by the choir

1 Hear my just cause, attend to my cry O Lord:
listen to my prayer from lips that do not lie.
2 Let judgment in my favour
come forth from your presence:
and let your eyes discern what is right.

3 You have searched my heart,
and visited me by night:
if you test me, you will find no wickedness in me,
my mouth does not offend.

4 With regard to human deeds:
because of the word of your lips,
I have avoided the ways of the violent.

5 My steps have been firm in your paths:
and my feet have not stumbled.

6 I call upon you O God for you will answer me:
